PLAGIARISM POLICY

Plagiarism is committed when someone copies someone else's work and submits it as their own. This offence can be committed during an exam, when submitting an essay, and when giving a presentation.

At English Path, students are expected to use citations in their essays and every essay will be checked for plagiarism. Students will be shown the proper format for giving credit and will be expected to write with academic integrity during tests, when submitting essays, and when giving presentations.

Students who commit plagiarism will be subject to disciplinary action in that -

- 1. They will receive an automatic 0 for their work
- 2. They are expected to re-do their work
- 3. Their 0 grade will stand until their new work has been submitted and it has been checked for plagiarism
- 4. A second submission of plagiarised work will result in expulsion from the course.
